

# Caroline and William Mark Memorial Award Nomination

This award was established in 1982 to recognize individuals for their accomplishments in either the research or clinical field, based on their lifetime contribution to laser technology. It is given in memory of Caroline and William Mark, who were pivotal in the formation of The American Society for Laser Medicine and Surgery. This award may be given to ASLMS members only. The award recipient will receive a plaque and \$2,000 at the Annual Conference and will be required to present a lecture at the conference.

The candidate must meet the following criteria in order to be considered for this award:

- 1) A caliber of work that has achieved previous recognition from his/her colleagues
- 2) Candidates should not be limited to individuals in academia, but should include representatives from areas of private clinical endeavor
