

Ellet H. Drake Memorial Award Nomination

This award was established in 1995 to recognize a practicing physician who has contributed to innovative laser procedures and/or laser products for medicine. It is given in memory of Ellet Drake, M.D., co-founder of the American Society for Laser Medicine and Surgery. This award may be given to either ASLMS members or non-members. The award recipient will receive a plaque and \$1,000 at the Annual Conference and will be required to present a lecture at the conference.

The candidate must meet the following criteria in order to be considered for this award:

- 1) A practicing physician with at least five years of practice
- 2) Contributed to innovative laser procedures and/or laser products for medicine
- 3) Contributed to literature and/or has demonstrated excellence in teaching on a regional or greater level substantiating his/her laser activity during his/her career
- 4) Good verbal communication skills to allow for an informative appropriate lecture
